

Privacy policy

Your privacy on the Internet is of utmost importance to the Smiling Hospital Foundation (the Foundation) . This privacy statement describes the Foundation's policy concerning the gathering and sharing of visitors' information through the Foundation's web site and other possible web based platforms.

You should note that through this site you may reach or be directed to other sites that relate to the Foundation's activities or the Foundation's sponsors' activities. All these sites have their own privacy statements which may vary from the Foundation's policies. By visiting the Smiling Hospital Foundation website you are accepting the practices described in this policy.

What information does the Smiling Hospital Foundation collect?

Normal website usage

In general, you can browse the Foundation's site without telling us who you are or revealing any personal information about yourself. The only information we gather during general browsing is from standard server logs (IP address, domain name, browser type, operating system, and information such as the web site that referred you to us, the files you downloaded, the pages you visit, and the dates/times of those visits).

Social media platform

Smiling Hospital Foundation has their own page on Facebook. Please note: you have the opportunity to „like” and „follow” our page however in case you change your mind, you can always choose „unfollow” or „unlike” the Foundation's page which mostly serves the role of sharing photos, videos and news of the Foundation's everyday life.

Collection of personally identifiable information

If you register as a volunteer/local coordinator or you in case you wish to donate to the Foundation via purchasing a product (Foundation's slippers) on the Foundation's website, you will be asked to provide personal information such as your full name and e-mail address (possibly your postal address – in case of purchase of products). This information is collected only with your knowledge and permission, and is kept in the Foundation's database.

What databases are the personal data recorded?

For volunteers: you will be asked the following personal details: full name, place and D.O.B., address, mother's maiden name, citizenship, email address, tel.number, current school or employer's details.
For local coordinators: you will be asked the following personal details: full name, place and D.O.B., address, mother's maiden name, email address, tel.number, tax number, social insurance number, bank account number.

For artists: you will be asked the following personal details: full name, place and D.O.B., address, mother's maiden name, email address, tel.number, tax number, social insurance number, bank account number.

For interested parties (companies, corporate sponsors): you will be asked the following: email address and possibly full name

Special note about information from children

Since the Foundation focuses on sick children's faster rehabilitation via entertaining and creative activities, keeping children's personal data is crucial. Personal data of children can only be collected the following way:

- children under 14 of age: any personal data can only be provided by the child's parents/guardians
- children in between 14 and 18 of age: personal data can only be provided with the child's parents'/guardian's prior authorization

What does the Foundation do with the information it collects?

Normal web usage

The information gathered during general browsing of the "mosolygokorhaz" domain is used to analyse trends and usage of the Foundation's site and to improve the usefulness of the site. It is not connected with any personal information. However, if you have registered as a volunteer or local coordinator in connection with any activity on the Foundation's site, the information we collect about your normal web usage will be identifiable to you.

Personally identifiable information

Smiling Hospital Foundation may use the personal information you provide to:

- Contact you – either in response to a query or suggestion, or to mail newsletters, documents, publications, etc. to you
- Manage and process your volunteer/local coordinator application
- Confirm your purchases and registrations on the site
- Remember your online profile and preferences
- Help you quickly find information that is relevant to you based on your interests and help us create site contents most relevant to you
- Undertake statistical analysis

What if I don't want to provide personal information?

Providing personal information on the the Foundation's site is optional. If you choose not to provide personal information, you can still browse and use the Foundation's site and other social media pages, but you will not be able to carry out certain actions such as purchasing products (e.g. slippers) or applying for a volunteering opportunities.

Opting out and changing your information

Security

We do not sell or share any personally identifiable information volunteered on the Foundation's site to any third party without prior consent. Any information provided by users of the Foundation's site is held with the utmost care and security, and will not be used in ways other than as set forth in this privacy policy, or in any site-specific policies, or in ways to which you have explicitly consented. However, the Foundation assumes no responsibility for the security of information.

The Foundation site contains link to sites external to the unicef.org domain. The Foundation is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such sites.
